PROCLAMATION

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR CHILDREN DAY MAY 20, 2026

WHEREAS, thousands of North Dakota children receive emergency medical care each year due to illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the goal of Emergency Medical Services for Children is to help states and communities prepare for an emergency involving a child through the provision of pediatric-ready emergency departments and emergency medical services (EMS) agencies; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services for Children relies on its established partnership within the EMS community, as well as multidisciplinary teams of health care providers across the emergency care system to help communities reduce child and youth disability and death due to severe illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the value and accomplishments of emergency medical services professionals serving children and their families and working tirelessly to improve the delivery of pediatric care across North Dakota's emergency care systems.
