WHEREAS, North Dakota retired teachers have dedicated their careers to the teaching profession and to serving our youth and the future of our state; and

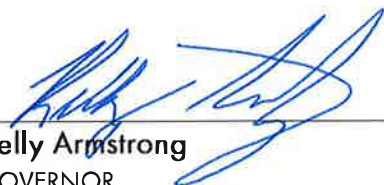
