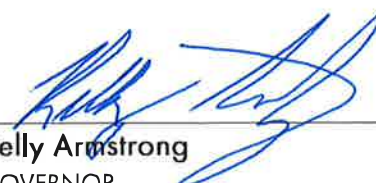
WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of North Dakota residents, young and old, participate in hunting and shooting sports every year; and
