WHEREAS, every North Dakotan deserves a fair and just opportunity to be as healthy as possible; and

WHEREAS, health equity requires removing obstacles to health such as poverty, discrimination, powerlessness, lack of access to good jobs with fair pay, quality education and housing, safe environments and health care; and

WHEREAS, health equity means reducing and ultimately eliminating disparities in health and its determinants that adversely affect excluded or marginalized groups; and

WHEREAS, an important step in achieving health equity is identifying social inequities in access to resources and opportunities needed to be healthier; and

WHEREAS, health equity and its determinants requires an examination of policies, laws, systems, environments and practices to eliminate inequities in the opportunities and resources needed to be as healthy as possible; and

WHEREAS, the American Indian Public Health Resource Center at North Dakota State University is hosting the first-ever, full-day event addressing health equity in the State of North Dakota; and

WHEREAS, the theme of the event, "Health Equity and Social Justice, Bridging the Gap," reflects the work done by communities, schools, government, faith-based organizations, businesses, non-profits and other partners to promote health equity in North Dakota.
