PROCLAMATION
NEUROMYELITIS OPTICA AWARENESS MONTH
MARCH 2018

WHEREAS, neuromyelitis optica spectrum disorder, more commonly known as NMO, is a life-threatening autoimmune disease of the central nervous system; and

WHEREAS, individuals with NMO develop optic neuritis (ON), which causes pain in the eyes, as well as vision loss, and transverse myelitis (TM); leading to weakness, numbness and sometimes paralysis of the arms and legs, along with many other life-altering side effects; and


WHEREAS, in the course of the disease, immune system cells and antibodies attack and destroy myelin cells in the optic nerve and the spinal cord; and

WHEREAS, NMO has been considered to be a severe variant of multiple sclerosis (MS), however, ongoing research suggests that NMO is a separate disease from MS. NMO differs itself from MS; and

WHEREAS, finding a cure for NMO has the potential to help cure other autoimmune diseases such as multiple sclerosis, lupus and many others; and



