

### What is LENA?

- National nonprofit on a mission to transform children's futures through early talk technology and data-driven programs.
  - 2x more likely to be ready for kindergarten
  - 80% increase in CLASS scores
  - 31% increase in healthy social behaviors
  - 2x increase in teacher retention

# Implementation Plan


Partnering with LENA to increase foundational early literacy skills in children birth to five. We are piloting with 10 classrooms this year to gather data to show the need for professional development and coaching.
