

## Governor Doug Burgum



## **EXECUTIVE ORDER 2023-02.1**

Doug Burgum, as Governor of the State of North Dakota, by virtue of the authority set forth in Article V, Section 1 of the North Dakota Constitution, hereby rescinds the following Executive Order previously issued because the Order is no longer necessary.

1. Effective immediately, Executive Order 2023-02, related to the establishment and appointing of an Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee, is rescinded.

ACCORDINGLY, this order is issued upon the following basis and for the following reasons:

- 1. The Governor is vested with the executive authority pursuant to Article V, Section 1 of the North Dakota Constitution; and
- 2. House Bill 1447 was passed and signed into law during the 68th Legislative Session. Effective August 1, 2023, Chapter 50-36 of the North Dakota Century Code has established a similar committee to receive and distribute funds received under courtapproved settlements with opioid manufacturers and therefore the Order is no longer necessary.
