WHEREAS, forensic nursing has been formally recognized as a specialty practice area since 1995; and

WHEREAS, forensic nurses provide specialized, compassionate and evidence-based medical care to survivors of domestic and sexual violence, abuse and human trafficking across the lifespan, while also playing a critical role in the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, forensic nurses are the bridge between the medical and legal needs of survivors, empowering survivors to seek healing and justice as they choose; and

WHEREAS, violence remains a persistent public health issue, with the health consequences of violence costing hospitals in the United States approximately \$18.2 billion annually; and

WHEREAS, individuals who experience violence may sustain physical injuries as well as acute and chronic health conditions, including sexually transmitted infections, substance use disorder, PTSD, anxiety and depression; and

WHEREAS, forensic nurses work collaboratively with law enforcement, prosecutors, advocates, military agencies and community organizations, ensuring that the provisions of care extends from the clinical setting to the courtroom.
