WHEREAS, collisions between farm equipment and motor vehicles can result in serious injuries and fatalities, highlighting the need for increased awareness and caution on the roads; and


WHEREAS, slowing down, staying alert and exercising patience while sharing the road with farm equipment can significantly reduce accidents and save lives; and

WHEREAS, farmers and motorists alike have a shared responsibility to practice safe driving habits to ensure that everyone reaches their destination safely; and


