



**EXECUTIVE ORDER 2019-08**

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2019-07, was issued on July 16, 2019, waiving the hours of service requirements for motor carriers delivering and distributing goods and services in North Dakota, specifically deliveries of cement and fly ash necessary for public infrastructure projects; and,

WHEREAS, subsequent guidance from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration has raised questions concerning the interpretation and application of U.S. Department of Transportation Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 390 to 399, relating to transportation and delivery of goods and services into and within North Dakota as described in Executive Order 2019-07.

NOW, THEREFORE, Doug Burgum, as Governor of the State of North Dakota, by virtue of the authority set forth in Article V, Section 1 of the North Dakota Constitution and North Dakota Century Code, hereby rescinds Executive Order 2019-07, effective immediately.
