PROCLAMATION

AMERICAN CLEAN POWER WEEK AUGUST 15-19, 2022

WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota boasts an all-of-the above energy portfolio, including wind, hydropower, solar and waste heat-generated power, which is supported by a reliable baseload provided by clean fossil fuel-generated energy; and

WHEREAS, clean energy makes up nearly 14% of the nation's electricity generation and provides enough clean energy to power over 57 million homes; and


WHEREAS, clean energy powers our state's economy as well, driving more than \$8 billion in total capital investment to date, \$20.7 million in annual state and local tax payments, and \$22.1 million in lease payments to North Dakota landowners; and

WHEREAS, clean energy provides more than 2,200 full-time jobs for North Dakota; and

WHEREAS, our state's commitment to clean energy has already proven to be a key component of our economic growth, and with continued investment we can remain at the forefront of energy innovation and development.
