PROCLAMATION

ARTS AND HUMANITIES MONTH OCTOBER 2022

WHEREAS, the nation's more than 100,000 cultural organizations, the National Endowment for the Arts, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the Institute of Museum and Library Services, the nation's more than 4,500 local arts agencies, and the arts and humanities councils of the United States' 56 states and jurisdictions are working together to promote the importance of arts and humanities nationwide; and
