ASIAN AMERICAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER HERITAGE MONTH MAY 2024

WHEREAS, the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community has contributed greatly to the history and culture of the United States, enriching the fabric of the nation through their art, music, literature, cuisine and traditions; and

WHEREAS, Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month was established in 1978 to honor the first Japanese immigrants who arrived in the United States on May 7, 1843, and to commemorate the completion of the transcontinental railroad on May 10, 1869, which was largely built by Chinese immigrants; and




