**WHEREAS**, this achievement highlights years of hard work, perseverance and dedication by Cara; and


**WHEREAS**, Cara is the first-ever Miss North Dakota to be crowned Miss America, and only the fourth to reach the top 10 of the competition; and

**WHEREAS**, Cara has also made public service a priority in her life by interning in the U.S. Senate and setting a goal for herself to hold public office; and


**WHEREAS**, people across the State of North Dakota are immensely proud of Cara and take pride in her victory.
