WHEREAS, study of the history, workings, influence, organization and evolution of governmental systems, political processes and political thought in the United States is at the very core of citizenship and civic duty; and


WHEREAS, civics awareness in North Dakota is important in informing students of the unique American experiment, including its system of limited government and its checks and balances designed to promote self-government; and
