### ELECTRONIC RECORDS DAY

OCTOBER 10, 2020

WHEREAS, electronic records are subject to changes in software and hardware that can leave them virtually inaccessible after just a few years if not monitored; and


WHEREAS, electronic records require proactive management at the time the records are created; and
