PROCLAMATION

EMERALD ASH BORER AWARENESS WEEK MAY 24-30, 2022

WHEREAS, more than 90 million ash trees exist in the forests of the great State of North Dakota, enhancing our state's air quality, natural landscapes, recreational destinations, wildlife habitats, property values and local economies; and

WHEREAS, as much as 80 percent of trees in some North Dakota communities are ash, helping residents reduce heating and cooling costs, reducing air pollution and storm water runoff, increasing property values and making our towns and cities some of the most beautiful in the country; and

WHEREAS, spring marks the beginning of the travel and tourism season in North Dakota, and increasing public awareness and understanding of the emerald ash borer, a destructive exotic beetle, will benefit the State of North Dakota by curtailing the artificial spread of the beetle through the movement of firewood; and


WHEREAS, efforts undertaken in North Dakota, in partnership with private and nonprofit organizations, universities and local, state, tribal and federal agencies are helping to protect the millions of ash trees in the state; and

WHEREAS, employing a cooperative spirit and encouraging partnerships and environmental stewardship throughout the states ultimately reduces the risk to the nation's ash resources; and

WHEREAS, Emerald Ash Borer Awareness Week is an opportunity for the state to join forces with environmental groups, community organizations, schools, businesses, industry, tourists and citizens to take action against the spread and introduction of emerald ash borer.
