EYE DONATION MONTH NOVEMBER 2019

WHEREAS, the first National Eye Donor Month was observed in March 1983 as the result of a proclamation read by President Ronald Reagan; and

WHEREAS, every year thereafter, a member of Congress has continued the tradition and reads a proclamation into the Congressional Record each November; and

WHEREAS, Dakota Lions Sight & Health, the only donation organization based in the Dakotas, provided 882 corneas to recipients in our area last year, restoring their sight and quality of life; and


WHEREAS, there were 807 individuals that made the selfless gift to donate their corneas in 2019; and


WHEREAS, in 2007, it was proposed and the North Dakota Legislature passed Senate Bill 2163, The Uniform Anatomical Gift Act, to promote donation; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota recognizes the importance of continuing to raise awareness of the need to donate, to recognize donors and their families, and to celebrate recipients.
