GASTROPARESIS AWARENESS MONTH AUGUST 2021

WHEREAS, gastroparesis is a chronic illness that affects more than 5 million people in the United States, yet it is an illness little known to many; and

WHEREAS, gastroparesis is paralysis of the stomach muscles which can cause debilitating pain, nausea, vomiting, early satiety and can lead to serious complications such as malnourishment, dehydration, extreme weight fluctuations, esophageal damage and dangerously erratic blood sugar levels; and


WHEREAS, there is little awareness, no known cure and few effective treatment options or medications for those affected by gastroparesis; and
