WHEREAS, North Dakota has provided significant leadership in the area of community involvement in the education and well-being of our youths, grounded in the principle that quality afterschool programs are key to helping our children become successful adults; and

WHEREAS, high-quality afterschool programs provide safe, challenging and engaging learning opportunities to students, helping them gain awareness and skills to compete in a 21st century workforce and contribute to the future strength of our state; and


WHEREAS, 19,865 North Dakota students are enrolled in an afterschool program; and North Dakota parents strongly support afterschool programs, with 86 percent supporting public funding for afterschool and 77 percent saying that afterschool programs support them in their work lives; and

WHEREAS, Lights on Afterschool, the national celebration of afterschool programs held this year on October 24, promotes the importance of quality afterschool programs in the lives of children, families and communities; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota is committed to investing in the health and safety of all young people by providing expanded learning opportunities that will help close the achievement gap and prepare young people to compete in the global economy.
