WHEREAS, 17,541 North Dakota students are enrolled in an afterschool program; and North Dakota parents strongly support afterschool programs, with 84% supporting public funding for afterschool and 88% saying that afterschool programs give them peace of mind; and

WHEREAS, Lights on Afterschool, the national celebration of afterschool programs held this year on October 28, promotes the importance of quality afterschool programs in the lives of children, families and communities; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota is committed to investing in the health and safety of all young people by providing expanded learning opportunities that will help close the achievement gap and prepare young people to compete in the global economy.
