

PROCLAMATION MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY AWARENESS MONTH AUGUST 2018

WHEREAS, muscular dystrophy strikes people regardless of race, sex, age or ethnicity; and

WHEREAS, more than 1 million individuals in the United States are affected by one of the different types of muscular dystrophy; and

WHEREAS, raising public awareness of these diseases will facilitate the continued discovery of treatments and cures, as well as bring much-needed funding for support and services to individuals and families affected by muscular dystrophy and neuromuscular diseases in North Dakota; and

WHEREAS, Muscular Dystrophy Awareness Month and Light Up Green for MD is a special opportunity to educate the public about muscular dystrophy and the issues in the muscular dystrophy community.
