WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota and Taiwan have a long and mutually beneficial relationship, as both partners enjoy close ties in two-way trade; and


WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota and Taiwan look forward to further promoting the relationship for mutual trade, education and cultural benefits; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2023, Taiwan observes its 112th National Day; and


WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota joins in observing this annual tradition and extends best wishes for a memorable celebration.
