

PROCLAMATION **NOTARY PUBLIC DAY** NOVEMBER 7, 2018

WHEREAS, since ancient Roman times, notaries public have recorded matters of judicial and commercial importance as well as private transactions when professional skill and integrity were needed; and

WHEREAS, notaries public have held a position of respect and dignity in North Dakota since 1893; and

WHEREAS, notaries public hold a trusted and integral role in our legal system; and

WHEREAS, as officers of the state, notaries public are vital to business transactions involving domestic and international commerce for our state; and

WHEREAS, notaries public are indispensable to the free flow of commerce and to many sensitive personal transactions; and

WHEREAS, notaries public provide an essential service to the community and are entrusted to perform their duties truthfully and with integrity; and

WHEREAS, citizens are encouraged to recognize North Dakota's 15,194 notaries public for their outstanding work and contributions to our state; and

WHEREAS, America's first notary, Thomas Fugill, was appointed on November 7, 1639.

NOW, THEREFORE, as Governor of the State of North Dakota, I do hereby proclaim November 7, 2018, **NOTARY PUBLIC DAY** in the State of North Dakota.
