WHEREAS, Patriots' Day is celebrated on the third Monday of April in remembrance and recognition of the Revolutionary War and the creation of the United States of America; and


WHEREAS, the Revolutionary War was fought to secure our natural rights and birthed a nation deriving its power from the consent of the governed; and
