
WHEREAS, Provider Appreciation Day offers a unique opportunity to recognize and commend child care providers for their dedication, compassion and strong family values; and


WHEREAS, North Dakotans are encouraged to recognize child care providers for the important work they do every day in shaping the lives and futures of our children.
