WHEREAS, school psychologists are trained to assess student- and school-based barriers to learning and individual strengths, use data-based decision-making, implement research-driven prevention and intervention strategies, and evaluate outcomes and improve accountability; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota should recognize the vital role that school psychologists play in the personal and academic development of our state's children.
