PROCLAMATION

SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY STATE

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution protects the right to keep and bear arms; and

WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1 of the North Dakota Constitution imparts certain inalienable rights upon its citizens, among those being the right to keep and bear arms to defend person, family, property and the state; these rights shall not be infringed; and

WHEREAS, the State has protected the rights of its citizens to possess and carry firearms; and

WHEREAS, the State has protected the right of firearm businesses to operate free from burdensome regulation and frivolous litigation; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Dakota will stand against federal overreach and attempts to limit rights to own and use guns; and

WHEREAS, President Biden and the United States Congress have announced intentions to pursue measures that will infringe on the right to keep and bear arms; and


WHEREAS, North Dakota will continue to take all necessary steps to defend our constitutional right to keep and bear arms.
